ABSTRACT

Peptic ulcer disease is a growing problem at Kariobangi Medical Centre. The health condition affects both the male and female gender.

The aim for this project was to determine the number of people who have peptic ulcers and the type of drugs used for the management and treatment for the condition.

The data was got from various hospital records and the X-Ray reports from the patients also the oral interviews that were conducted to the patients who were attending the medical centre. Then it was analysed through descriptive analysis.

The results showed that 426 patients out of 1500 of the patients who attend the medical centre in the year 2006 had P. U. D though 54.2% were male while 45.77% were female hence the number of males was more than the female. The drug that is mostly used to manage P. U. D in the medical centre is Histamine blocker.

From the results of the data got indicated that more men suffer from P U D than women in the medical centre.
