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ABSTRACT

The study was aimed at determining the important elements in cowdung, which are necessary for plant growth. The samples were taken from two cattle bomas in the Ngong area and its main aim was to investigate the advantages to which cowdung could have over inorganic fertilizer. The samples were taken for some chemical analysis, which involved percentages of Nitrogen, Potassium and Phosphorus, which were recorded and graphically represented. The study showed that cowdung manure can be used as an alternative for inorganic manure.

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
